Sgt Julian Abraham P.794237 PAF



Julian was born on 6 November 1923, in Lviv, Poland.

He was an Air Gunner in the Polish Air Force, serving with 18 O.T.U. at RAF Bramcote, Warwickshire.

Wellington IC R3280 took off from Bramcote airfield on 11 September 1942, on a night training mission. A wireless SOS which was sent at 2347 hours, suggested that they were over the Irish Sea, in the vicinity of the Isle of Man, but no trace of the aircraft was ever found; and the crew were listed as missing presumed dead.

Julian's body was never recovered, and he is commemorated at the Polish Air Force Memorial, Northolt, Middlesex. He was 18 years old.
