William came from Bitterne, Southampton. His parents were William and Ellen Addison.

He served with 207 Squadron, based at Langar, as a Wireless Operator/Air Gunner. He was a Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve member.

On 27 August 1943, his 13th Operation, he was in Lancaster ED627 EM-N on an operation to Nuremberg when his aircraft was brought down by enemy action near Schwabisch Hall, Germany. The whole crew perished.

He is buried in the Durnbach War Cemetery in Germany. He died when he was only 21.
