

P/O Horace Badge 155766 RAFVR



Horace was born in Camelford, Cornwall, the son of Ernest and Florence Badge.

He served with 207 Squadron, based at Langar, as a Pilot. He was a RAF Volunteer Force member.

Horace was killed in action whilst on an operation to Turin on 12 July 1943. He was flying in Lancaster ED412 EM-Q when the plane crashed into a mountain, Le Grammont, in atrocious weather near Le Bouveret in Switzerland. His plane was one of 13 aircraft lost on this raid.

He is buried in Vevey (St Martin's) Cemetery, Switzerland. He died when he was only 20.
